

MODIFIED CHECK LIST FOR REGISTRATION OF NEW EATING HOUSES

1.	Documents for proof of identity & residence of the applicants – Aadhar Card or in case the applicant does not have Aadhar Card, a written declaration to be submitted in the form of an Affidavit along with an alternative identification proof which may include – Passport, Voter Identification Card, PAN Card or Identity Card issued to the employees.
2.	Proof of ownership/tenancy/lease of premises of the Eating Houses, (registered sale deed, registered lease/rent deed).
3.	Certificate of Incorporation of Proprietorship, LLP, Partnership, Limited, Private Ltd., Public Ltd., Company.
4.	Names of Directors & Current DIR – 12& Board Resolution for conducting business; Nomination of Authorised signatory/ partners, on letter head.
5.	Prescribed Affidavit for Eating House License.
6.	<p>Fire Safety Certificate from Delhi Fire Service, if the eating house has covered area of 90 sq. m. or more.</p> <p align="center">OR</p> <p>The following information, if the eating house has covered area less than 90 sq. m.:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Total number of floors/storeys in the building. 2. Height of the building in meters. 3. Covered area of the establishment in sq. meters (as defined in building bye laws). 4. Occupant load as per NBCL/UBBL 2016 & Delhi Fire Service Rules, 2010. 5. Sanctioned plan/regularized plan/completion plan of the building including section, elevation, if available. <p align="center">Or</p> <p>As built plans of the building including section, elevation having details of covered area, location and dimension of means of escape (Exit door, stair case, corridor etc.) certified by the registered architect/empanelled engineer duly marked fire and life safety arrangements as stipulated under rule-33 of Delhi Fire Service Rules, 2010 duly signed by owner/occupier/authorized signatory.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 6. Year of construction of building. 7. Date of conversion of occupancy of establishment proposed/initial date of operation of assembly occupancy (Eating House/Restaurant) in this building. 8. Number of staircases. 9. Width of staircases 10. Width of doors. 11. Width of corridors.
7.	The following minimum fire safety measures shall be taken by the applicant, if the eating house has a covered area less than 90 sq. m:

	<p>a) Automatic fire-suppression system viz. fire sprinkler system, gaseous fire suppression, and condensed aerosol fire suppression should be installed in the kitchen</p> <p>b) Adequate number of portable fire extinguishers should be kept at appropriate locations</p> <p>c) Exhaust systems should be installed</p> <p>d) Inflammable material should be stored in a safe place away from the public area</p> <p>e) Fire alarm systems should be installed</p> <p>f) Adequate number of fire/emergency exits duly marked should be provided.</p> <p>g) The passages should be kept free from any obstruction, hindrance and temporary features</p> <p>h) The fire/emergency exits should be kept clear and free from any obstruction, hindrance and temporary features</p>
8.	Current MCD/NDMC/DCB/Airport operator Trade License
9.	GST Registration Certificate in the name of Eating House/Company.
10.	Registration Certificate under Shops & Establishment Acts, issued by Labour Department, GNCT of Delhi.
11.	FSSAI Certificate.
12.	<p>Does the Establishment permits/ proposes to permit smoking in the premises.</p> <p>Note: Eating Houses with seating capacity below 30 seats are not permitted to provide smoking zone.</p> <p>If no, furnish affidavit on the prescribed format declaring that the Establishment is a complete no smoking area.</p> <p>If yes, details of space earmarked for smoking in terms of G.S.R. No. 500(E) dated 23rd May, 2017, (COTPA Act 2003).</p>
13.	DPCC Consent Letter. If the applicant is not able to produce the consent letter at the time of application, provisional registration will be allowed subject to the condition that the applicant complies with the pollution control norms and he/she shall furnish the same within the stipulated time granted by this authority.
14.	Proof of installation of CCTV system with 30 days recording such as invoice, technical report of installation, or AMC, and photographs, etc.
15.	List of all employees with name, parentage & address along with Police Verification Certificate or proof of submission thereof in jurisdictional Police Station.

All photocopies be self-attested by applicant

- # NOC/ Affidavit/ undertaking/ Indemnity Bond should be given on a stamp paper of Rs. 10/-.
- # The Licensing Authority may require production /submission of additional documents, if so required.
- # The applicant should clearly mention in the affidavit, whether the applicant will also hold amusement activities such as Live Band, DJ, Discotheque etc. and should undertake to obtain separate licence/s under relevant regulations.
- # The applicant should clearly mention in the affidavit, whether the applicant will also operate a Bar and should undertake to obtain separate licence under the Delhi Excise Act, 2009.
- # The applicant should submit a self-attested affidavit if the applicant entity's annual turnover is less than Rs. 20 lac and is exempted from registration under the GST Act, 2017.
